In Manatee County on 09-29-10 at 0826 the defendant, Raymond Roberts, violated F.S.S. 901.36 by doing the following: I was conducting radar speed enforcement with Deputy E. Lawson at the 500 block of 63rd Ave E. I observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed. I estimated the vehicle's speed to be 35 mph and Deputy Lawson verified the vehicle speed to be 36mph with stationary hand held radar GHD-07343. I then initiated a stop on the Hyundai bearing Florida tag R894AH and made contact with the driver. Upon my approach to the vehicle I smelled a strong odor of marijuana coming from the interior of the vehicle. I asked the driver for his license and registration and learned that the driver was Raymond Roberts. I then gave Deputy Lawson the drivers information and advised him that I smelled the odor in the vehicle. Deputy Lawson then completed the citation and had the driver sign the citation. After he completed his signature, I asked Roberts if he smoked marijuana and when he did that last. He stated he smoked last night and there was nothing in the car and to search the car. I then asked him if he had anything on him and he stated he did not. I then searched his immediate person and felt a soft object in the crack of his buttocks. When I asked Roberts what that was, he began to tense up and move from his position on the patrol vehicle. I then told him that I felt something and he stated "let me get it, hold on". He then placed a clear plastic baggie with a green leafy substance in the hood of the vehicle. I then asked him if that was it and he stated "yes". I then searched his shorts again and felt another object that was in the crack of his buttocks again. I pulled the object out from the exterior of his shorts and a clear plastic baggie with a white rock substance fell to the ground. Roberts immediately stated "the white stuff is not mine, but the weed is". He then stated that his friend borrowed the vehicle and he observed it on the passenger seat when I pulled him over. The rock substance was tested and was positive for cocaine and weighed a total of 3.5 grams with 27 pieces in the bag. I also tested the green leafy substance which was positive for marijuana and weighed 4.5 grams.
